

My name is Randy Moore. I am an R.N. with strong wound care, trauma, and pediatric experience. I have a strong missions and business background as well. I have just returned from three weeks in Haiti caring for victims of the earthquake. I am raising the support to return to Haiti for another three months beginning March 3. I would love the opportunity to present an overview of the work being done prior to leaving, or on one of my return trips.



While in Haiti I learned that there are still an estimated 100,000 injured people in Port Au Prince that have not received medical care. Due to the very real fears these people have of being robbed due to their weakened states, they will not leave their homes. To provide these people with the care they need, the medical care will have to be taken to them. One of my first objectives will be to establish medical clinics in some of the worst parts of Port Au Prince to serve these people.

While working in Cap-Haitien, I met a Catholic priest who had built an operating room and clinic 2 years ago on the outskirts of town. It was literally like finding a diamond in the mud. During my three weeks in the country, I was able to find a general surgeon and anesthesiologist to come in and perform the first operations ever done at this facility. Frer Giordani has asked that I continue helping locate, schedule, and coordinate U.S. medical teams to work at this facility. Currently we have three weeks of March scheduled with different surgical teams.

In the short term I will be working with existing Haitian groups to provide the needed emergent health care and food distribution in response to the needs that were exacerbated by the disaster. Long term; I am working with Food for the Poor, The Catholic Medical Mission Board, and several concerned Haitians in helping provide quality college level and post grad education in the country, along with helping create job opportunities through micro-loan programs and additional job opportunities in health care and education facilities.



I write this seeking your prayers as well as your financial support. Initially, I am seeking the funding to be able to work in Haiti for three months. At the end of that time period, I will reassess, with God's guidance, the direction of further work. I have budgeted \$9,000 for this three month period to start neighborhood medical clinics in Port Au Prince, help with food and medicine distribution, and to continue a micro-loan program that was initiated during my last visit.
